Pillar 2

data from swab testing for the wider population, as set out in government guidance

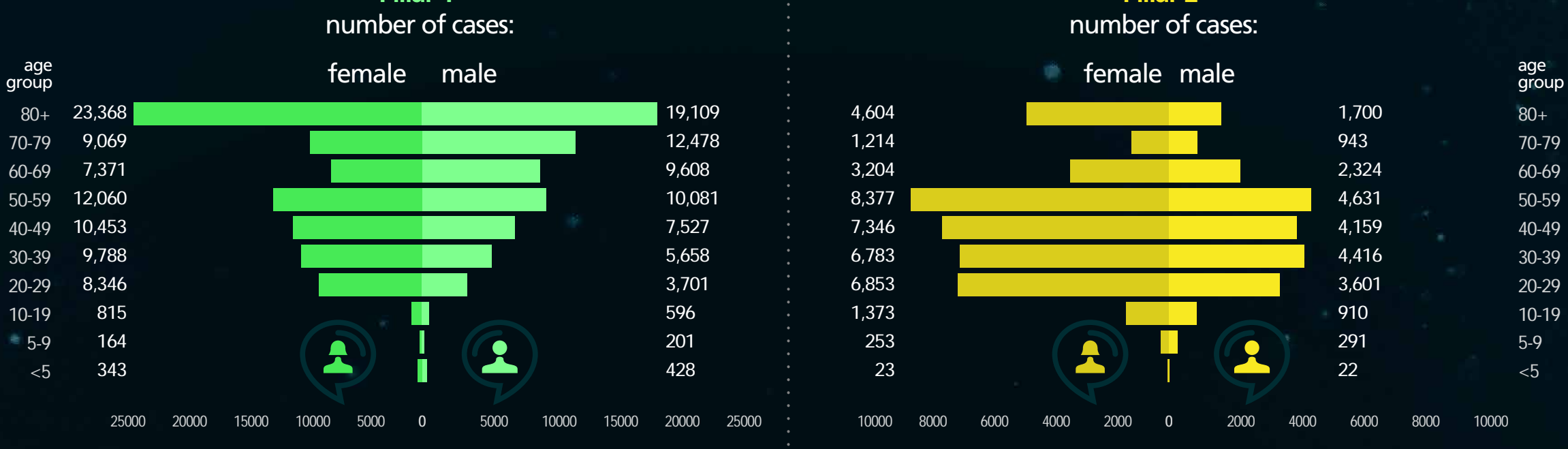

POPULATION PYRAMID OF CASES

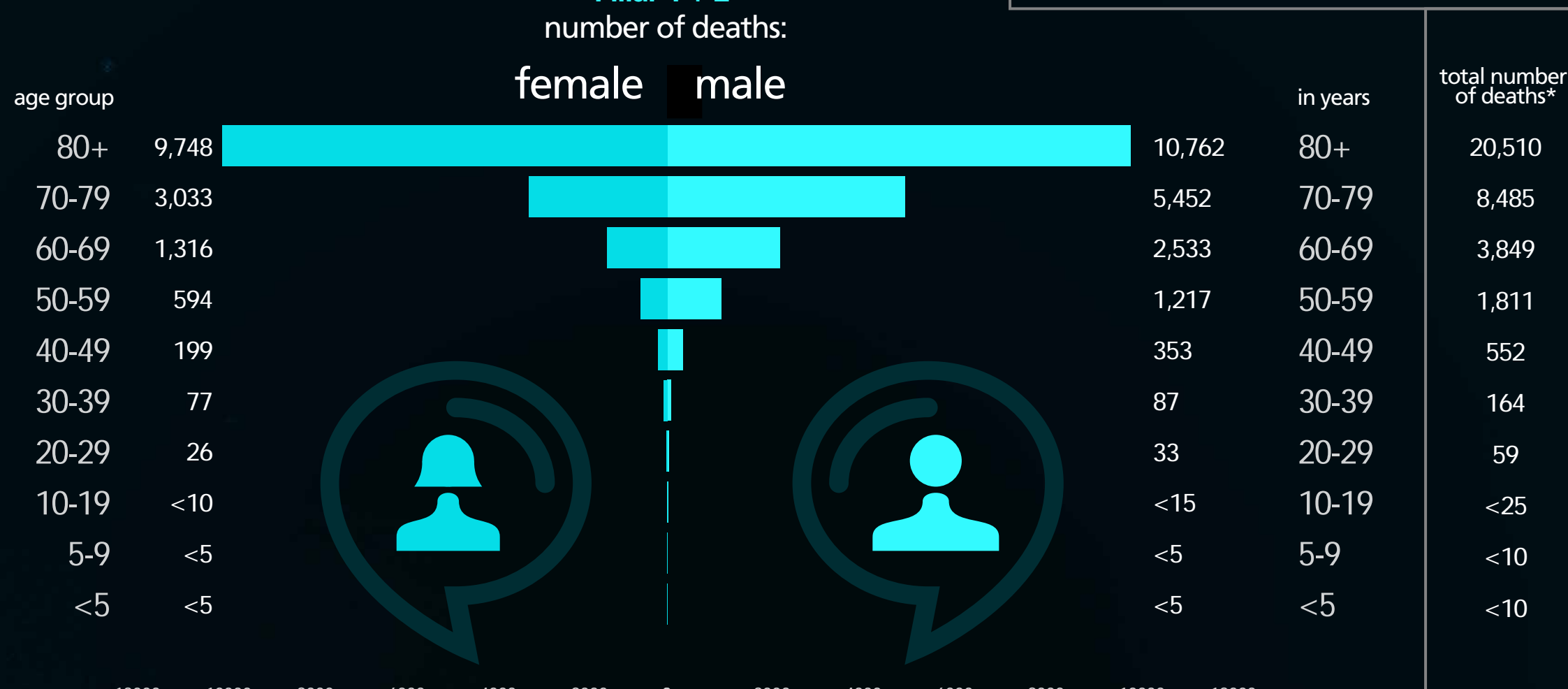

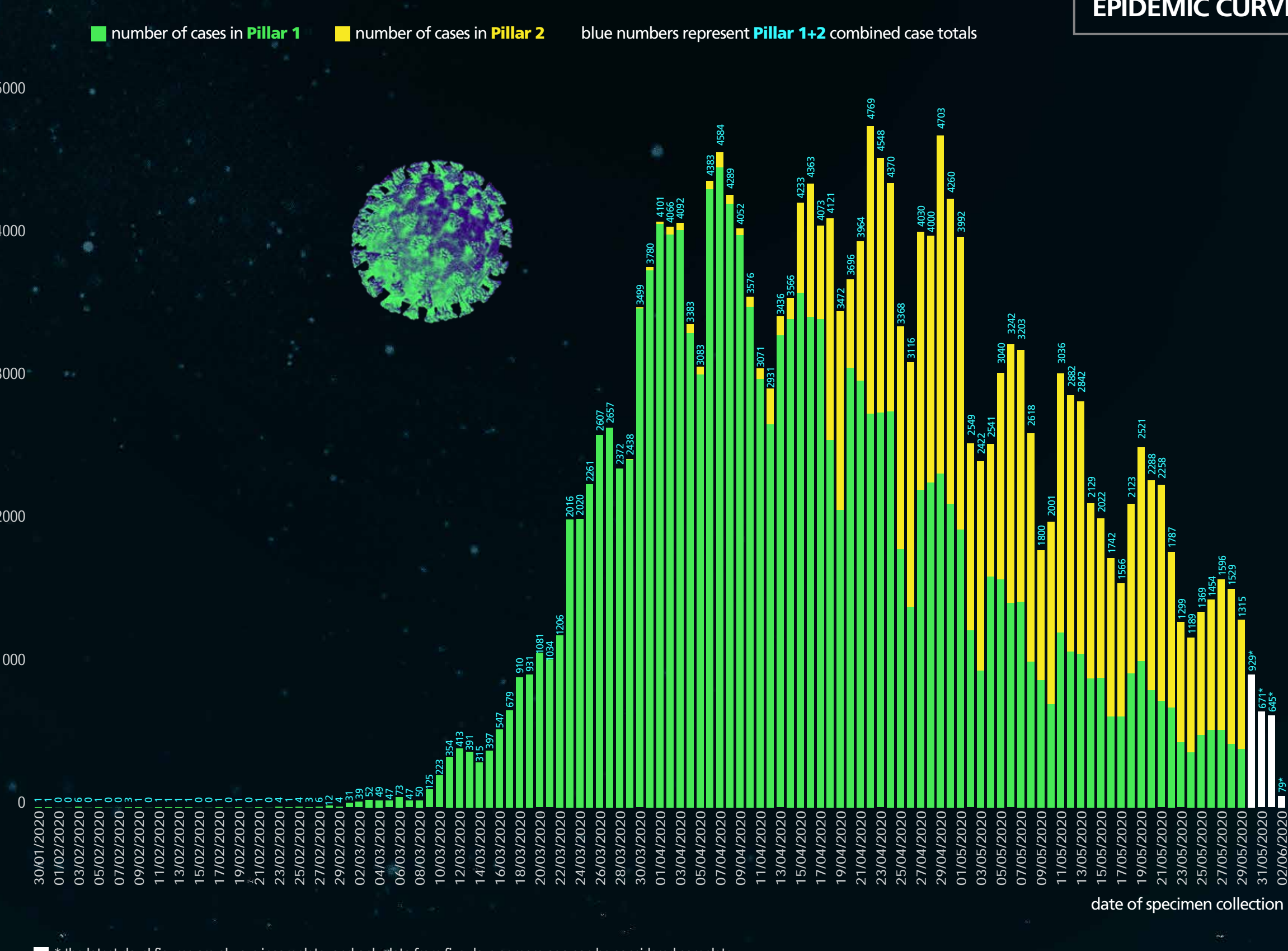

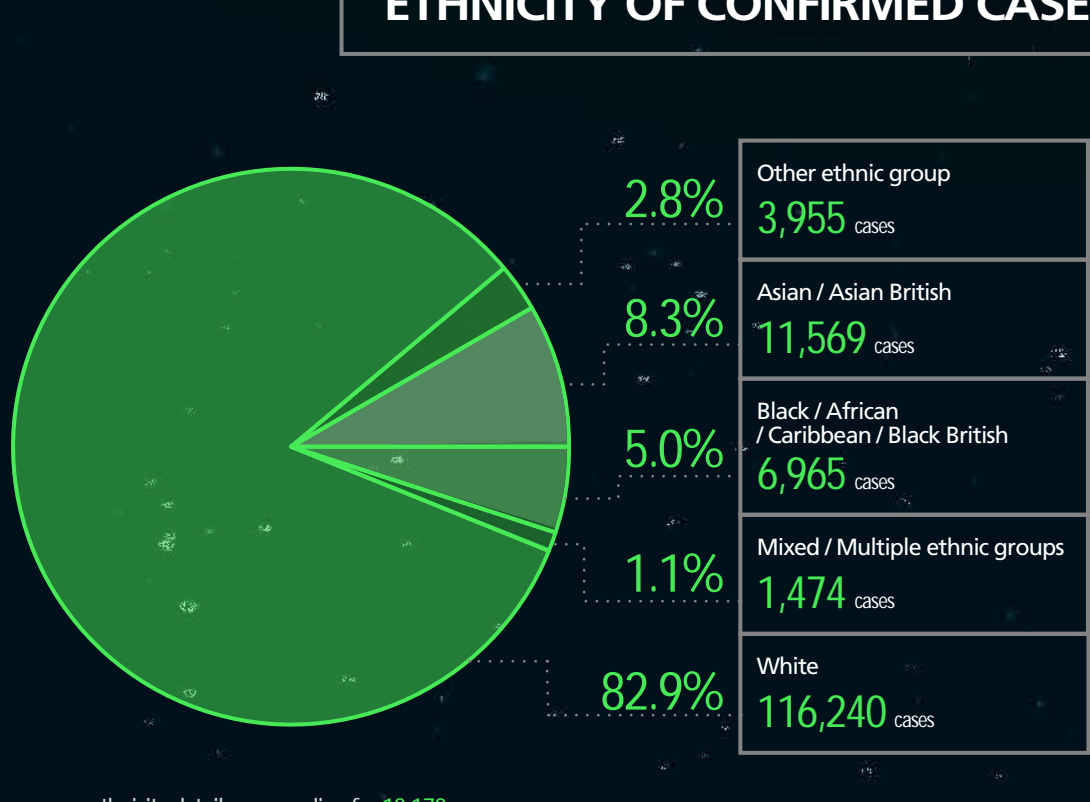
POPULATION PYRAMID OF DEATHS



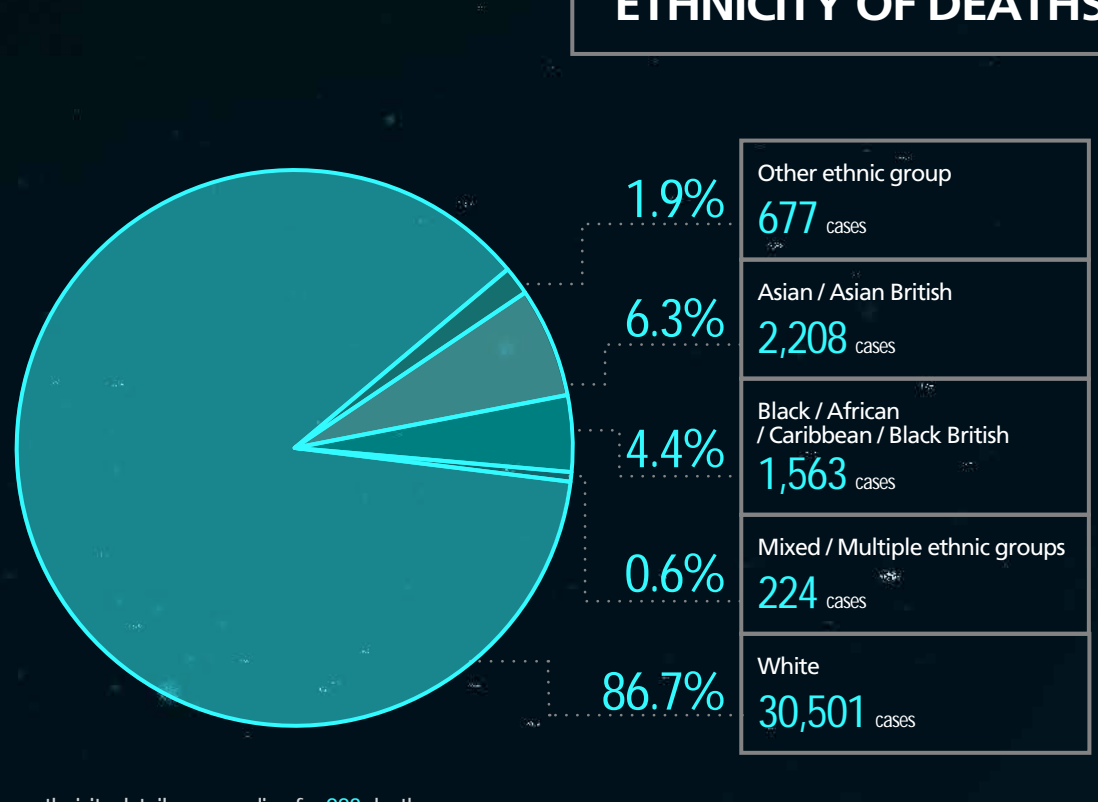
EPIDEMIC CURVE



ETHNICITY OF CONFIRMED CASES



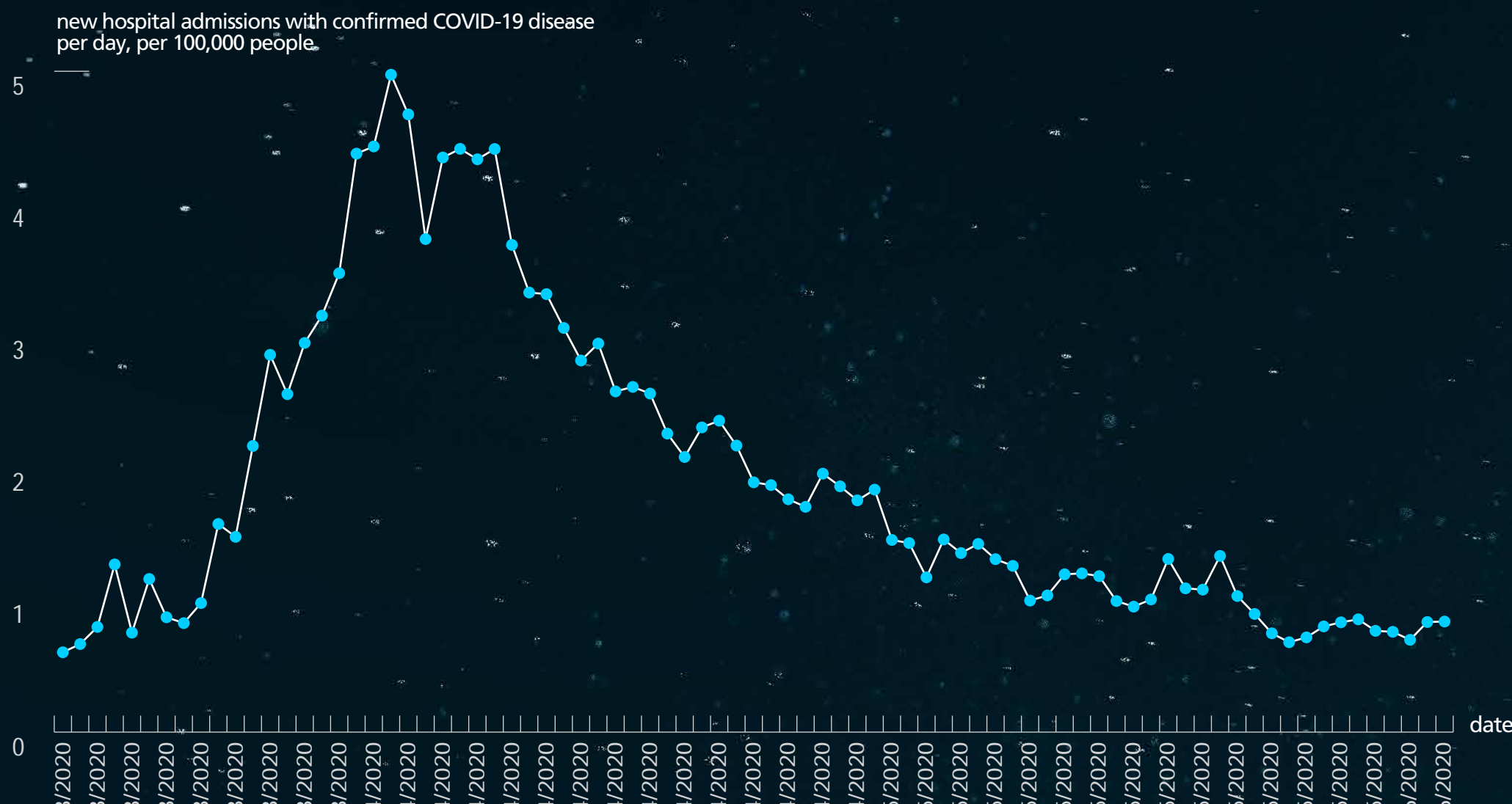
ETHNICITY OF DEATHS
