Breakdown of testing by Pillars of the UK Government's COVID-19 testing programme:

Pillar 1 + 2

combined data from both Pillar 1 and Pillar 2 of the UK Government's COVID-19 testing programme

Pillar 1

data from swab testing in PHE labs and NHS hospitals for those with a clinical need, and health and care workers

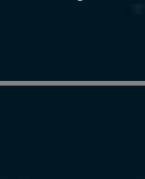
Pillar 2

data from swab testing for the wider population, as set out in government guidance

Pillar 4

data from swab testing for PHE, the Office for National Statistics (ONS), research, academic, and scientific partners

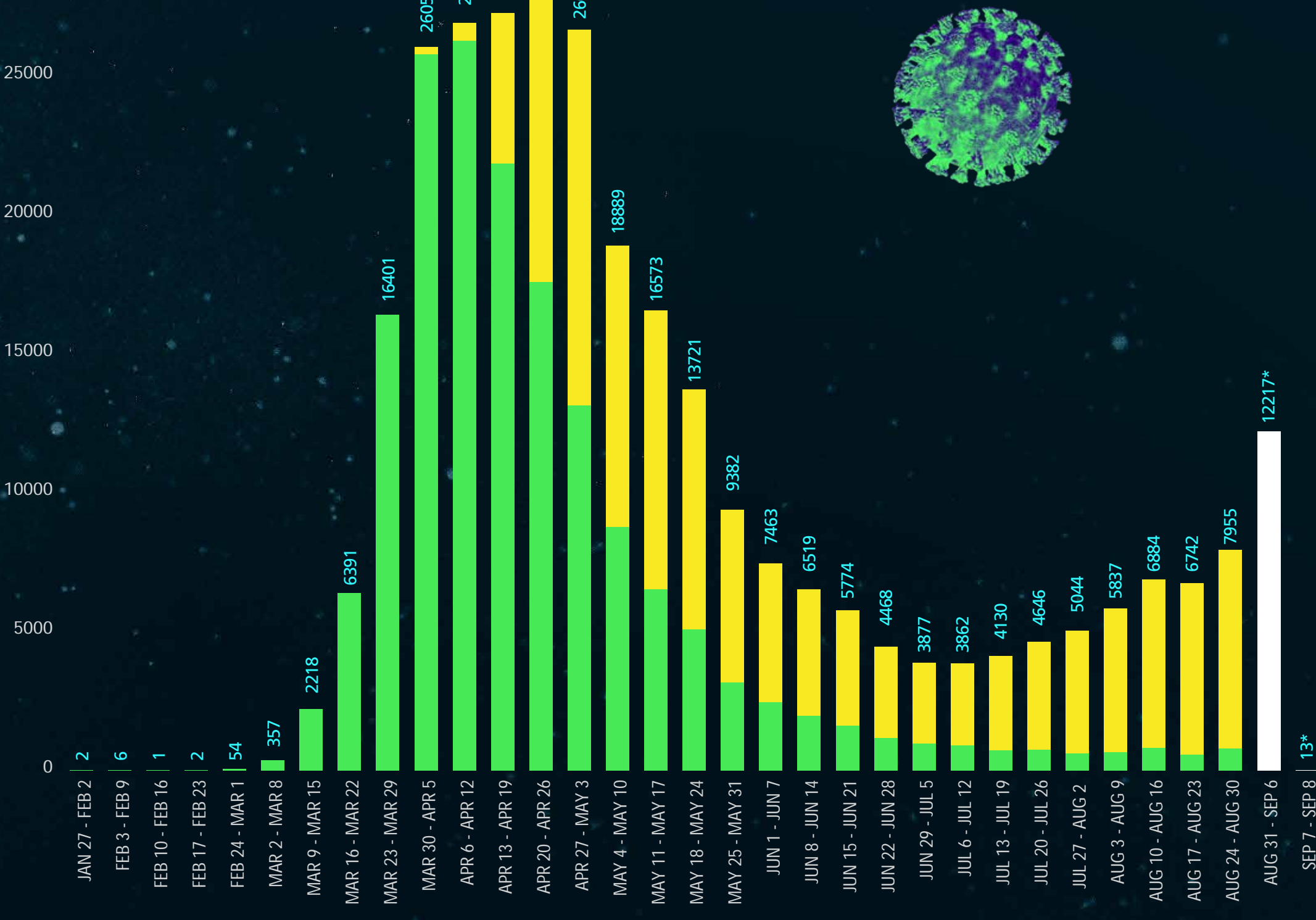

Public Health England are notified of positive cases detected in Pillar 4 (research studies) and this data flows into the Surveillance system. This means that all positive cases identified by Pillar 4 surveillance studies are captured under Pillar 1 or Pillar 2
